

International Workshop on Archaeological Soil Micromorphology & DIG (Developing International Geoarchaeology) conference DIG2015

Dear Colleagues,

We are happy to inform you that the 2015 *International Workshop on Archaeological Soil Micromorphology* and the DIG2015 (*Developing International Geoarchaeology* 2015) - *Conference*, will take place in Sardinia, Italy on the following dates:

- 5-8 June Micromorphology Workshop In the Dept. of Chemical and Geological Sciences of Cagliari University. (Please note: places for the workshop are 35, will be distributed on a first come first served basis. Hence, in order to be quaranteed a place, it is recommended to book early)
- 9-12 June DIG2015 (Sassari University at Alghero, Department of Architecture and Design).

The Workshop is the traditional microscope-based meeting of the **International Archaeological Soil Micromorphology Working Group**. Participants to the Workshop are invited to bring their thin sections and a short (3 minutes) Powerpoint presentation discussing the slides. The thin sections will be made available to be looked at by all participants and for discussion during the 3 days of microscope sessions, and the 3 minute presentations will all be shown during the 3 days.

DIG 2015 is a conference of the **Developing International Geoarchaeology** (**DIG**) group for 2015. **DIG** (http://www.developinginternationalgeoarchaeology.org/first.html) is the title of a series of very successful international conferences. The goal of DIG is to bring together a wide variety of international researchers, practitioners and students in this diverse and interdisciplinary field in order to facilitate discussion, stimulate research, and promote international scholarship in geoarchaeology.

On 8 June, after the workshop, and just before DIG2015, there will be a half day **excursion to the site of Fordongianus** (http://www.forumtraiani.it). Both participants to the Workshop and/or to DIG2015 will be able to attend this if they wish. The DIG2015 conference will be held over the days following the workshop, and will be followed by **another excursion to different sites in Sardinia**. Further information will be given in the next circular.

Registration and exprtession of interest: If you wish to attend both Workshop and DIG2015, or only one of the two, please let us know. We ask you to please send us by January 31st an expression of your interest (See attached form) in attending either (or both) event. A full program and information will be available after we receive the expressions of interest.

Presentations

The workshop is a practical microscope session, and Participants to the Workshop are invited to bring their thin sections and a short (3 minutes) Powerpoint (or else) presentation to introduce their

slides to the participants.

Abstract submissions are now being accepted for oral and poster presentations for the DIG2015. Submissions should include a title, name and affiliation of author(s), contact address of corresponding author, and an abstract of not more than 600 words length. Please indicate whether you prefer an oral or a poster presentation. We will try to respect your preference, but may not be able to do so; you will be informed at a future date of whether your presentation will be scheduled as oral or poster. **Presentations concerning any aspect of geoarchaeology are welcome**. Abstracts can be submitted to: dig2015submissions@gmail.com. **Deadline date for submissions: February 28th 2015.**
